Report

Case: "Huber"

Genealogical study done in records of the Catholic parishes of Beutelsbach, Neukirchen vorm Wald and Aldersbach (all boroughs in the county of Passau, district of Lower Bavaria, State of Bavaria) in the diocesan archive in Passau.

The task was to find information about Peter Huber (born approx. in 1837), his parents (Michael Huber from Anham, born approx. 1813, died approx. 1886, and Anna Leingartner, born approx. 1816, died approx. 1894) and their ancestors.



It was possible to confirm most of the already known dates for the parents and grandparents of Peter Huber (2); he was born in Gumperting on June 28, 1837 as second child of Michael Huber (4) and his


later wife Anna Leingartner (5), who married in Neukirchen vorm Wald on July 14, 1841. The couple had in total ten children, born between 1835 and 1855 (the first three out of wedlock), one daughter Franziska died in early childhood, one son Joseph Huber died with 50 years in 1891 due to a fall from the threshing-floor during threshing at his brother Michael. The parents of Michael Huber (4) were Michael Huber (8), farmer in Anham ("Schönhofer"), and his wife Theresia Wiblinger (9), who married in Beutelsbach on July 2, 1822. Their parents were Michael Huber (16), farmer in Anham ("Liendlbauer"), and his wife Anna N. (17) resp. Stephan Wiblinger (18), farmer in Anham ("Einödbauer"), and his wife Catharina N. (19). The parents of Anna Leingartner (5) were Josef Leingartner (10), farmer in Gumperting ("Niedermair"), and his wife Theresia Neißendorfer (11), who married in Aldersbach on September 22, 1801. Their parents were Lorenz Leingartner (20), farmer in Weng ("Nömer"), and his wife Catharina N. (21) resp. Franz Neißendorfer (22), farmer in Gumperting ("Fösten"), and his wife Magdalena N. (23).




Map of the area between Straubing and Passau with Aldersbach, Beutelsbach and Neukirchen vorm Wald (map from www.google.de/maps)




Map with Aldersbach, Beutelsbach, Anham, Gumperting and Weng




Map with Neukirchen vorm Wald and Pirking




Anham on a map from mid of 19th century (from geoportal.bayern.de)
