Genealogical study done in records of the Catholic parishes of Beutelsbach (borough in the county of Passau, district of Lower Bavaria, State of Bavaria) in the diocesan archive in Passau and of Tisch (district of Krumau, Bohemia, Austria; today: Ktiš in Okres Prachatice, Czech Republic) in the Czech archive in Třeboň.

The task was to find information about Theresia Reisinger (born maybe in or near Straubing) and her ancestors.

I checked the parish records of six parishes in the town of Passau, but couldn't find any baptism or marriage record of the family between the 1850's and 1864. Obviously Passau was only the name of the county they were from.


Then I checked the records of Beutelsbach and could find the baptism records of two illegitimate children of the Huber/Reisinger family, both were born illegitimately:

- Franz Seraphim Huber/Reisinger: Born in Aicha on July 25, 1862.
- Peter Huber/Reisinger: Born in Aicha on April 30, 1864, died in Aicha on September 28, 1864 due to convulsions ("Fraisen")


Their mother was Theresia Reisinger (3), who was born illegitimately in Aicha on January 27, 1842 as daughter of the bricklayer assistant Aloys Reisinger (6) from Vilshofen and of Magdalena Machhart (7) from Aicha, who married later in Beutelsbach on December 31, 1855. Aloys Reisinger (6) was the illegitimate son of Aloys Reisinger (12), scribe in Vilshofen, and of Katharina Fröschl (13), unmarried

bricklayer's daughter. Aloys Reisinger (6) was bricklayer and farmer ("Gütler") in Aicha on the farm "Veicht", he was born in Vilshofen approx. on November 8, 1812 and died in Aicha on August 25, 1877 due to a stroke ("Schlagfluß"). His wife Magdalena Machhart/Liedlbauer (7) was also born illegitimately in Aicha on March 29, 1820, she died in Aicha on October 30, 1871 due to dropsy ("Hydrops"). Her father was Joseph Machhart (14), who was farmhand ("Bauernknecht") in Aidenbach at the inn "Gesl Bräu" and came from Bohemia (Austria in those times). His origin was named as "Neuburg in Böhmen" resp. "Neuburg der Pfarr Tischer", which is undoubtful the place Neuberg in the parish of Tisch (in Czech: Ktiš) in the district of Krumau (Böhmisch Krumau, in Czech: Český Krumlov). Up to now I couldn't find his birth record in the records of Tisch, but the family name Machhart was common in that parish. Magdalena Machhart/Liedlbauer's (7) mother was Gertraud Liedlbauer/Lienlbauer (15), who was born in Aicha on March 3, 1791 as daughter of the farmer Peter Lienlbauer/Liendlbauer (30) on the farm "Veicht" and of his wife Gertraud N. (31) from the farm "Nöbauer" in Kettenham, who died in Aicha on May 26, 1842 as widow. Gertraud Liedlbauer/Liendlbauer/Lienlbauer (15) had at least three illegitimate children from two different fathers:


- Michael Kallhamer: Born in Aicha on February 3, 1812; father was the farmer's son Georg Kallhamer from Bruck.
- Magdalena Machhart (7).
- Franz Paul Kohlhammer: Born in Aicha on February 4, 1826; father was also Georg Kohlhammer from Bruck. Franz Paul became later a Catholic priest (he was 1864 Cooperator in Schönberg); he did the funeral of his mother (15) in Beutelsbach on June 30, 1864, who died in Aicha on June 27, 1864 due to cardiac dropsy ("Hydrops pericardii").
